Please use the Consumer Guide to search for and compare nursing homes, residential care (assisted living) facilities, and supportive living facilities and to learn more about services in your home and community that may meet your needs.

At any time during your search, if you want to switch the type of home to review, just choose a different facility type using the top menu bar. Other facility types include:

- Assisted Living (RCFs). Licensed as Residential Care Facilities, these residences generally provide meals, housekeeping, laundry, transportation, and social activities. They also offer personal care, such as assistance with eating, bathing, grooming and personal hygiene. Some nursing care may also be provided.
- Supportive Living Facilities. These homes, also referred to as Adult Care Facilities, provide room, board and personal care for individuals who need assistance with daily living.
- Residential Treatment Facilities. These room and board to persons with mental illness. They all require a referral from a hospital, mental health agency or practitioner

After choosing to search for Nursing Homes, the site will display a page titled “Nursing Homes, including short-term rehabilitation.” The page has a great deal of information to help you in your search – tips on selecting a nursing home, how they’re licensed, how to pay for nursing home care and who to call for help in selecting or to report a problem.

## Nursing Homes, including short-term rehabilitation

Nursing Homes serve consumers needing more medical services than those available through home care, assisted living and other options. Nursing Homes do not necessarily mean long-term care; more than half of all nursing homes stays are for three months or less. Increasingly, nursing homes are used to complement and supplement other care options, including assisted living, hospital and home care particularly for short-term rehabilitation. The [Ohio Department of Health](#) licenses and/or certifies nursing homes and conducts on-site inspections/surveys for compliance with state and federal rules and regulations.

To determine if a nursing home is a good option for you, contact your [Area Agency on Aging](#) and request a free assessment.

### How to Select?

There are almost 1,000 nursing homes in the state of Ohio. How do you determine which will meet your needs? The first steps involve reviewing the possibilities to narrow your selection:

**Services.** Review the services each nursing home offers for those that will meet your needs. Each facility may indicate on the Long-Term Care Consumer Guide the special services they offer. Does the facility's description of services match the medical, social and community connections you desire?

**Location.** Use the geographic search function to find nursing homes within a comfortable travel distance from friends and family.

**Quality Indicators.** All consumers of long-term care services deserve excellent care. The Long-Term Care Consumer Guide contains the following information about each nursing home licensed by the State of Ohio and/or certified for Medicaid/Medicare by the federal government. 

The facility search page will allow you to search for a facility by Geography and by the services available in the facility. The Type of facility will already be marked for “nursing homes”. You may wish to search by county, by the city, or by the distance to your zip code.

We recommend you choose one search type at a time – not all three – to ensure you get sufficient responses to review. If you’re in a rural area, start with a county search; in a large city, you may want to start with 5 to 10 miles from your zip code. To search by zip code, simply enter your 5 digit zip code into this box, then drag the marker to the left or right to increase or decrease the distance for your search.



If you have a few nursing homes in mind already, you may wish to enter the names here in the Keyword Search box, separated by a comma. Use few of the words in the name – for instance, type “Happy Hills” for Happy Hills Nursing and Rehabilitation Center.


